The workshop provides an overview of ISO 14064-1:2018, and guidance on how to prepare inventories consistent with it.

Content coverages includes:

- Preparing audit reports, opinions, boundary setting and consolidation approaches;
- Inventory development and structure;
- Emission sources and classification under the 2018 ISO14064 standard;
- Audit requirements for verification of your inventory;
- Similarities and differences between the ISO 14064 and the Greenhouse Gas Protocol; and
- Common pitfalls, errors and how you navigate your team to get the data you need to make informed decisions and take action on “SDG 13 – Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts”.

This training course is aimed at carbon and sustainability professionals, who want to gain skills in developing organisational GHG inventories.
