The course will include a mix of audit theory and practical activities.

Who will benefit most from this training?

This is a training course aimed at carbon professionals with a working knowledge of ISO 14064-1 who want to develop skills in auditing organisational GHG inventories.

Please note: This course has the pre-requisite of the CEP 'Preparing a Carbon Inventory course', or equivalent for participants who <u>do not</u> have a working knowledge of ISO14064-1.
